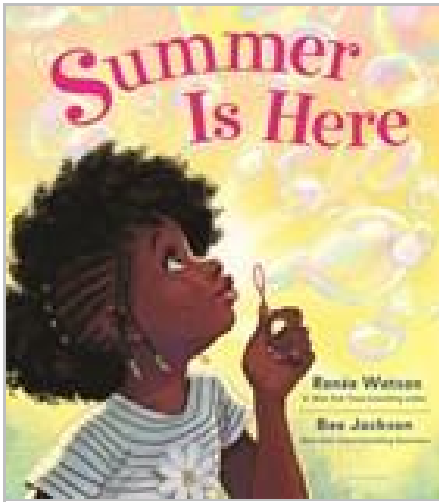

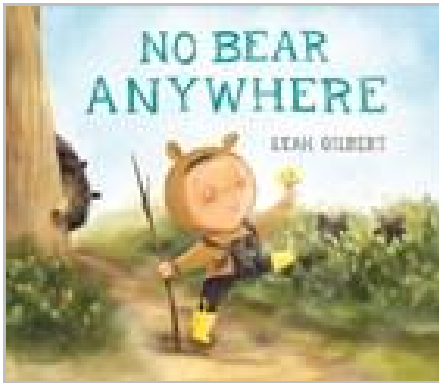

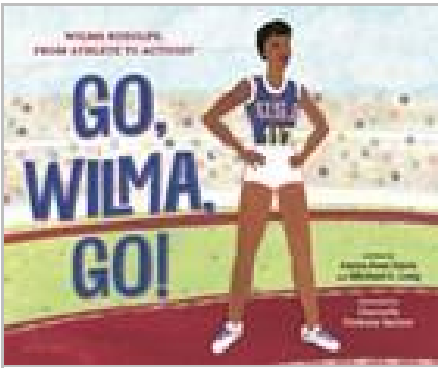

Most people know Wilma Rudolph as a record-setting Olympic track athlete, but fewer know she was also an activist. This nonfiction picture book tells the powerful story of what happened *after* she soared across the finish line to become a gold medal winning Olympian.

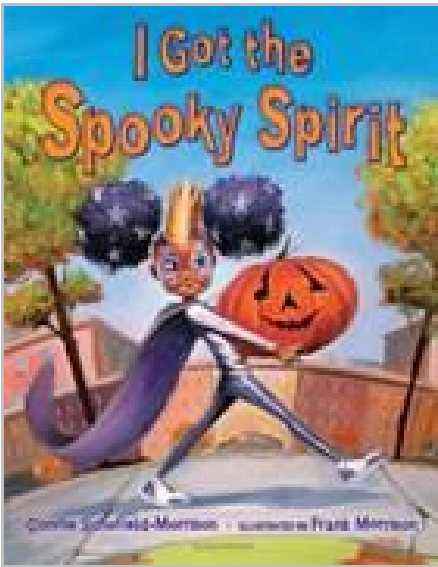
When she returned home to Clarksville, TN, she used her platform to demand that her town de-segregate the parade and banquet they were planning in her honor—and they did! After she was honored with the first integrated celebration in Clarksville, Wilma's work was just beginning. For the rest of her life, she would use her platform to protest segregation and advocate for Black girls and women to have opportunities in sports and beyond.

This moving picture book is sure to inspire the next generation of athletes and changemakers.

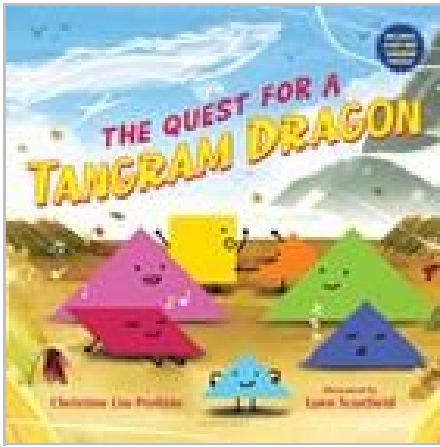

Christine Liu-Perkins and Lynn Scurfield, creators of Chinese descent, introduce the classic Chinese Tangram puzzle to young readers in a clever and warm-hearted story about the power of persistence and teamwork.

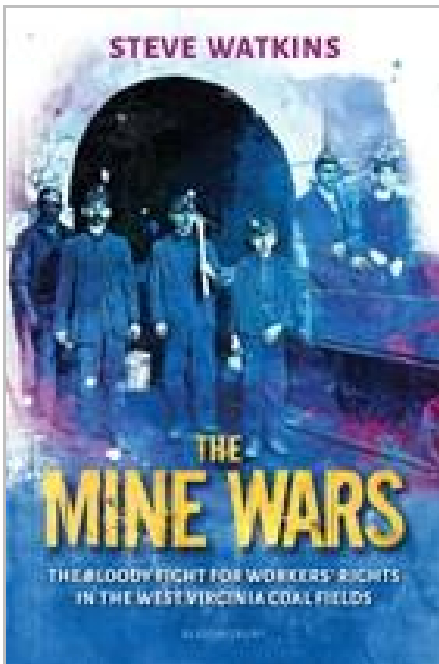

In May 1920, in a small town in West Virginia, a dozen coal miners took a stand. They were sick of the low pay in the mines. The unsafe conditions. The brutal treatment of workers. The scrip they were paid—instead of cash—that could be used only at the company store.

They had tried to unionize, but the mine owners dug in. As tensions finally boiled over, a gunfight erupted—and began a yearlong standoff.

The miners tried protests; they tried strikes; the owners retaliated with spying, bribery and threats. It would all culminate in the Battle of Blair Mountain, the largest labor uprising in US history.

In this gripping book, get to know the spirited people who fought for the rights of coal miners, and discover how the West Virginia Mine Wars paved the way for vital protections for workers of all kinds.

Steve Watkins is an award-winning author of more than ten books for young readers, including the 2009 Golden Kite Award winner for fiction, *Down Sand Mountain*. He has also written several books for grown-ups including a short story collection that won a Pushcart Prize. He is also a journalist and former professor of journalism at the University of Mary Washington, a world-renowned yoga instructor, and a father to four daughters.
